BEGINNING BAND SYLLABUS

I've included information about the instrument process for beginning band.

A word of advice from previous experience is to stay away from websites or Amazon deals that seem too good to be true. Band Director Approved is their favorite thing to put on the site and that is seldom true. Buying on Facebook Marketplace or Amazon makes it hard to tell if the instrument is working properly. Obviously, we want an instrument that is in good working condition so that your child has a good opportunity for success.

Beginning Band FAQ

- Beginning band is a year-long course.
- Instruments taught in the beginning band are flute, clarinet, trumpet, trombone.. Upon director recommendation, students may move to other instruments (oboe, bassoon, bass clarinet, saxophone, tuba, and percussion) after the first quarter.
- No prior musical experience is necessary for the beginning band.
- Our beginning band classes meet during the school day; students will not lose time in the other core subjects while in band.
- Each beginning band student will need to supply their own instrument, instrument cleaning supplies, and band book.
- Instruments should be in good playing condition. Those that are purchased from a source other than
 Hill's Music Shoppe should be approved by Mr. Riggs, as some instrument brands are very unreliable or
 difficult to repair.
- It is sometimes necessary to limit the number of students on a particular instrument to achieve proper balance of instrumentation.

2. Supplies (For All Mills Park Band Members)

- The TonalEnergy app for a smart device (or a stand alone metronome and tuner) for home practice
- 1"-1.5" three ringer binder
- 20 clear document pages
- Pencils

Lessons:

Private lessons, highly recommended for students in band. As a student improves, a greater collection of literature becomes available to them and will enable them to excel, which in turn improves the band. With the aid of private instruction, students also find greater opportunity through experiences like all-county, all-district, and all-state band. Many parents have found that enrolling their child in private lessons pays back when they receive college scholarships. Over half of students who continue band through high school receive some or all payment for college.
