Our spring concert is scheduled for **Monday, May 20th**. Please read the information carefully so that our performance will be enjoyable and rewarding for everyone involved.

Times The concert begins at 6:00pm. However, students will need to arrive early for warm-up (*see below*). ALL STUDENTS AND PARENTS PLEASE ENTER THROUGH THE FRONT OF THE BUILDING (MAIN ENTRANCE). This is the first of two concerts (the 7th grade band and 8th grade band perform at 7:00pm), so please exit quickly at the conclusion of the concert.

6th Grade: Arrive at 5:30pm. Assemble instruments in band room, and leave cases in *band lockers*. Be seated in the *gym performance seats* with instruments and music, ready for warm-up by 5:40pm.

Jazz Band: Arrive at 5:40pm. Assemble instruments in band room, and leave cases in *band lockers*. Be seated in the reserved section of the *gym* with instruments and music, by 5:50pm.

Tardiness will be reflected in the student's grade.

Program Each band will play a program of approximately 15 minutes. The entire concert should conclude by 6:35pm.

Other Details Part of the educational experience in music is concert etiquette. All students are therefore required to stay for the entire concert. Also, please keep in mind that this is a mandatory performance. If there are unavoidable and excusable conflicts with this performance, the director must be notified in writing prior to the concert date. The circumstances must meet the criteria for an excused absence as outlined in the band handbook, in order for the student to be excused.
