Dear band members and families:

Our spring concert is scheduled for **Tuesday, May 22nd**. Please read the information carefully so that our performance will be enjoyable and rewarding for everyone involved.

Times The concert begins at 7:00pm. However, students will need to arrive early for warm-up (*see below*). ALL STUDENTS AND PARENTS PLEASE ENTER THROUGH THE FRONT OF THE BUILDING (MAIN ENTRANCE). This is the second of two concerts (the 6th grade band and jazz band perform at 6:00pm), so please do not enter the gym before the first concert has concluded. Additional parking may be available in front of the elementary school.

7th Grade: Arrive at 6:30pm. Leave cases in *band lockers*. Be seated in the *gym performance seats* with instruments and music, ready for warm-up by 6:40pm.

8th Grade: Arrive at 6:40pm. Leave cases in *band lockers*. Be seated in the reserved section of the *gym* (directly behind the performance setup) with instruments and music, by 6:50pm.

Tardiness will be reflected in the student's grade.

If there are unavoidable and excusable conflicts with this performance, the director must be notified in writing prior to the concert date. The circumstances must meet the criteria for an excused absence as outlined in the band handbook, in order for the student to be excused.
